**ORDER ON NONPARTIES' MOTION TO
EXTEND THE DEADLINE TO FILE MOTIONS
TO QUASH AND/OR LIMIT SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM**

On May 17, 2013, nonparties Fannin Regional Hospital, Trinity Hospital of Augusta, and Flowers Hospital (collectively the "Subpoena Recipients") filed an Unopposed Motion to Extend the Deadline to File Motion to Quash or Limit Subpoenas *Duces Tecum*. The motion requests an extension of time through and including May 22, 2013 to file any motion to quash and/or limit the subpoenas with respect to Short Form Request 3 and Long Form Request 9 served on the Subpoena Recipients on or about April 26, 2013 (the "Subpoenas") by Respondents Phoebe Putney Health System, Inc., Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital, Inc., and Hospital Authority of Albany-Dougherty County (collectively, "Respondents").

The Subpoena Recipients state that they are in the process of negotiating with Respondents over the breadth of the Subpoenas, but that as of the time of the filing of the Motion, definitive agreements have not been reached. Accordingly, the Subpoena Recipients request an extension of the deadline to file a Motion to Quash and/or Limit the Subpoenas under Commission Rule of Practice 3.34(c), 16 C.F.R. § 3.34(c), to May 22, 2013. The Subpoena Recipients state that the motion is not opposed by Respondents.

Based on the foregoing, the Motion of nonparties Fannin Regional Hospital, Trinity Hospital of Augusta, and Flowers Hospital to Extend the Deadline to File a Motion to Quash or Limit Subpoenas *Duces Tecum* is hereby GRANTED, and it is further ORDERED that the deadline for the Subpoena Recipients to file any motions to quash or limit Subpoenas shall be May 22, 2013.
