ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO EXTEND THE DEADLINE FOR FILING A RESPONSE TO THE COMPLAINT

On June 13, 2013, Respondents Pinnacle Entertainment, Inc. and Ameristar Casinos, Inc. ("Respondents") filed a motion requesting a thirty-day extension for Respondents to respond to the Complaint, from the current deadline of June 17, 2013.
