## ORDER GRANTING SECOND MOTION TO EXTEND THE DEADLINE FOR FILING A RESPONSE TO THE COMPLAINT

On July 15, 2013, Respondents Pinnacle Entertainment, Inc. and Ameristar Casinos, Inc. ("Respondents") filed a motion requesting an additional fourteen-day extension for Respondents to respond to the Complaint, from the current deadline of July 17, 2013. By Order dated June 13, 2013, Respondents were previously granted a thirty-day extension for filing a response to the Complaint.

In support of this motion, Respondents state that, since service of the Complaint, counsel for Respondents and Complaint Counsel have made significant progress in resolving this matter without the need for administrative litigation and that Respondents anticipate that this matter will be resolved by execution of a consent order, thereby rendering unnecessary a response to the Complaint. Respondents further state that Complaint Counsel does not oppose the extension sought.

Respondents have demonstrated good cause for extending the deadline for their time to respond to the Complaint. Accordingly, pursuant to Rule 4.3(b) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, the motion is GRANTED and it is hereby ORDERED that the deadline for Respondents to respond to the Complaint is extended to July 31, 2013.
