Dear Mr. Peterman:

The Commission's Bureau of Competition has been conducting a non-public investigation to determine whether Abbott Laboratories, Solvay SA, or any other person are engaging in unfair methods of competition in violation of Section 5 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, including, inter alia, by monopolizing or attempting to monopolize the market for fenofibrates by preventing or slowing generic competition to TriCor.

Upon further review of this matter, it now appears that no further action is warranted by the Commission at this time. Accordingly, the investigation has been closed. This action is not to be construed as a determination that a violation may not have occurred, just as the pendency of an investigation should not be construed as a determination that a violation that a violation has occurred. The Commission reserves the right to take such further action as the public interest may require.

In accordance with Rule § 4.12 from the FTC Rules of Practice, the Commission will dispose of "all materials determined not to be appropriate for preservation" unless the submitting party requests those materials' return. We will destroy the documents that Abbott submitted, unless you request their return by June 11, 2010, and arrange to retrieve them or provide us with your account number for a delivery service.
