Dear Mr. Allen:

The Boston Regional Office of the Federal Trade Commission has conducted an investigation to determine whether the Catfish Institute violated the Federal Trade Commission Act by making false and misleading claims as to the fat, calorie, and cholesterol content of farm-raised catfish.

Upon further review of this matter, and based, in part, on your representation that the Catfish Institute will not disseminate any nutrient content claim for farm-raised catfish that is inconsistent with the Federal Trade Commission's Enforcement Policy Statement on Food Advertising, 59 Fed. Reg. 28388 (June 1, 1994), it appears that no further action is warranted by the Commission at this time. Accordingly, the investigation has been closed.

This action is not to be construed as a determination that a violation may not have occurred, just as the pendency of an investigation should not be construed as a determination that a violation has occurred. The Commission reserves the right to take further action as the public interest may require.
