The Federal Trade Commission's Bureau of Competition has been conducting a non-public investigation to determine whether DVD Copy Control Association, Inc. and certain of its members may have engaged in unfair methods of competition in violation of Section 5 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, 15 U.S.C. § 45, as amended, by imposing unreasonable conditions upon licensees of the Content Scramble System.

Upon further review of this matter, it now appears that no further action is warranted by the Commission at this time. Accordingly, pursuant to authority delegated by the Commission, the investigation has been closed. This action is not to be construed as a determination that a violation may not have occurred, just as the pendency of an investigation should not be construed as a determination that a violation has occurred. The Commission reserves the right to take such further action as the public interest may require.
