The Federal Trade Commission's Bureau of Competition has been conducting a nonpublic investigation to determine whether Immucor, Inc., or any other unnamed persons, partnerships, or corporations have engaged or are engaging in conduct that violates Section 5 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, as amended, 15 U.S.C. § 45, through acquisitions of competitors that developed, manufactured, or sold blood testing products in North America or through other anticompetitive conduct with respect to blood testing products.

Upon further review of this matter, it now appears that no further action is warranted by the Commission at this time. Accordingly, the investigation has been closed. The action is not to be construed as a determination that a violation may not have occurred, just as the pendency of an investigation should not be construed as a determination that violation has occurred. The Commission reserves the right to take such further action as the public interest may require.
