The Commission has conducted an investigation to determine whether the United Space Alliance, a joint venture between Lockheed Martin Corporation and Rockwell International Corporation, may violate Section 7 of the Clayton Act or Section 5 of the Federal Trade Commission Act.

Upon further review of this matter, it now appears that no further action is warranted by the Commission at this time. Accordingly, pursuant to authority delegated by the Commission, 49 Fed. Reg. 6171 (1984), the investigation has been closed. The Commission reserves the right to take such further action as the public interest may require.
