

The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) will be releasing a requirement for Information Technology Support Services (ITSS) on GSA's IT Schedule 70, SIN 132-51. At this time, FTC anticipates a five-year, multiple award BPA valued at approximately \$100M focusing on the following functional areas: modernization from FTC's current on premise environment to cloud-based service models enterprise service desk and user support services; networking, operations and maintenance and infrastructure support services; and on premise and cloud hosted application development and support services.

The FTC will hold an Industry Day to present an overview of the Office of the Chief Information Officer's (OCIO) ITSS Blanket Purchase Agreement (BPA) acquisition, encourage industry interest, promote collaboration between large and small businesses, and to answer questions regarding ITSS.

Government representatives will provide briefings encompassing, but not limited to the current FTC environment; technical objectives and goals of the BPA; alignment with FTC's modernization strategy; and acquisition approach. This will be an open forum style engagement and one-on-one interactions with government personnel will not be conducted during the forum. Immediately following the briefing, all parties in attendance will have one and a half hours to meet and talk with other attendees to discuss teaming and subcontracting opportunities.

All interested parties are required to register for the Industry Day no later than October 13th, 2016. Seating is limited at the event, registration is on a first-come, first-serve basis and no parties without a confirmed registration statement from the FTC will be permitted to attend the event.

In your request, include the name(s) of the attendees, company name, and contact information. It is the government's intent to make the final list of attendees available to industry.

Upon arrival to the Noblis facilities, each individual will be required to present Government-issued photo identification and complete security-screening procedures prior to gaining access to the facility. There will be no exceptions granted.
