Ms. Askin is counsel for international antitrust at the U.S. Federal Trade Commission's Office of International Affairs. Ms. Askin works with the International Competition Network (ICN) and coordinates the FTC's participation in the ICN's advocacy working group and Inter-American Competition Alliance. Ms. Askin is responsible for bilateral cooperation and case coordination with competition authorities in Africa, the Middle East, and Western Europe. She also conducts technical assistance workshops focused on antitrust theories of harm and investigative skills.

Ms. Askin started her antitrust career in private practice at Howrey LLP and Baker Botts L.L.P. working on U.S. and non-U.S. merger, conduct, and cartel matters. She has worked on the U.S. Senate Committee on the Judiciary and at the Delegation of the European Union to the United States of America.
