**Re: *In the Matter of California Association of Legal Support Professionals*

Thank you for your comments regarding the proposed Consent Order in the matter of California Association of Legal Support Professionals (“CALSPro”). The Commission carefully reviewed all the comments received from you.¹

The proposed Consent Order requires that CALSPro cease and desist from prohibiting its members from (1) offering discounted rates to rivals’ clients, (2) engaging in certain comparative advertising, and (3) recruiting employees of competitors without first notifying the competitor. Your comments relate to alleged actions by the National Association of Professional Process Servers (“NAPPS”), rather than the proposed Consent Order with CALSPro.

The Commission has determined that the public interest is served by issuing the Decision and Order in final form. Enclosed is a copy of the final Decision and Order. Relevant materials are also available from the Commission’s website at <http://www.ftc.gov>.
