Thank you for commenting on the Federal Trade Commission's proposed consent agreement in the above-referenced proceeding. The Commission has placed your comment on the public record pursuant to Rule 4.9(b)(6)(ii) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 4.9(b)(6)(ii), and has given it serious consideration.

As we understand your comment, you visited a Paramount Ford dealership and purchased a new vehicle that you consider to be a lemon. We appreciate your comment. This action applies to Paramount Kia of Hickory LLC, and its successors and assigns, and not to a Paramount Ford dealership. Please be aware that you may file a consumer complaint online at ftc.gov/complaint to provide more details about your experience, and we encourage you to do so. In addition, you may wish to report lemon law concerns to your state authorities.

After due consideration, the Commission has determined that the relief set forth in the consent agreement is appropriate and sufficient to remedy the violations alleged in the Complaint. Accordingly, the Commission has determined that the public interest would best be served by issuing the Decision and Order in this matter in final form without modification.
