**ORDER GRANTING *IN CAMERA* TREATMENT FOR  
DOCUMENTS RELATED TO A FORMER LABMD EMPLOYEE**

By Order dated May 6, 2014, the parties' joint motion seeking *in camera* treatment for certain exhibits containing sensitive personal information pertaining to a former LabMD employee was granted. On May 27, 2014, the parties filed a Joint Motion for *in camera* treatment for additional exhibits relating to that same employee. The parties represent that the parties overlooked certain sensitive personal information pertaining to this former employee in certain deposition transcripts.

For the reasons stated in the May 6, 2014 Order, permanent *in camera* treatment is GRANTED for the sensitive personal information contained in CX0704, CX0710, CX0715, RX486, RX492, and RX497, and to any related testimony at the evidentiary hearing.
