Dear Ms. Johnson:

Thank you for your March 23, 2014 comment in the above-referenced matter. Your comment expresses concern about the efficacy of wireless components of your ADT system. You also raise concerns about credit reports.

The proposed complaint is limited to allegations that ADT used paid expert spokespersons to promote the ADT Pulse without adequately disclosing the material connection between the experts and ADT. Although, the complaint does not address the issues you raised in your comment, the Commission is committed to protecting consumers from any unfair or deceptive acts or practices in commerce and has forwarded your comment to the FTC's Consumer Response Center.

After considering your comment, along with others received in this matter, the Commission has determined that the public interest would best be served by issuing the Decision and Order in final form without modification.
