**ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION OF NONPARTY
PRICEWATERHOUSECOOPERS LLP TO EXTEND THE DEADLINE
TO FILE A MOTION TO QUASH AND/OR TO LIMIT SUBPOENAS**

On October 14, 2014, nonparty PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP (“PwC”) filed an Unopposed Motion to Extend the Deadline to File a Motion to Quash and/or Limit Subpoena *Duces Tecum* and Subpoenas *Ad Testificandum* served on PwC (“Motion”). The subpoenas at issue were served by Federal Trade Commission (“FTC”) Complaint Counsel on October 3, 2014 (“Subpoenas”).

The Motion requests an extension of the applicable deadline to file a motion to quash and/or limit subpoenas under FTC Rule 3.34 until October 21, 2014.¹ PwC states that counsel for PwC and Complaint Counsel have conferred in a good faith effort to resolve PwC's objections to the Subpoenas; that such discussions are ongoing; and that the requested extension will allow adequate time to resolve PwC's objections by agreement. Further, PwC states, Complaint Counsel does not oppose PwC's requested extension of time.

Based on the foregoing, the Motion is GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that the deadline for PwC to file a Motion to Quash and/or Limit the Subpoenas is extended through and including October 21, 2014.
