**ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION OF NONPARTY
UNITEDHEALTHCARE TO EXTEND THE TIME TO FILE A MOTION TO QUASH,
OR IN THE ALTERNATIVE TO LIMIT, SUBPOENA *DUCES TECUM***

On October 14, 2014, nonparty UnitedHealthCare filed an Unopposed Motion to Extend the Time to File a Motion to Quash or in the Alternative Limit, Subpoena *Duces Tecum* served on UnitedHealthCare (“Motion”). The subpoena at issue was served by Federal Trade Commission (“FTC”) Complaint Counsel on October 2, 2014 (“Subpoena”).

The Motion requests an extension of the applicable deadline to file a motion to quash and/or limit the Subpoena under FTC Rule 3.34 until October 21, 2014.¹ UnitedHealthCare


¹ Rule 3.34(c) provides in pertinent part: “Any motion by the subject of a subpoena to limit or quash the subpoena shall be filed within the earlier of 10 days after service thereof or the time for compliance therewith.” 16 C.F.R. § 3.34(c).

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states that it is in the process of negotiating with Complaint Counsel over the breadth of the Subpoena, and its objections thereto, in a good faith effort to comply with its obligations, while reducing the burden imposed by the Subpoena. Further, UnitedHealthCare states that Complaint Counsel has been consulted regarding the Motion and Complaint Counsel does not oppose the requested extension of time through October 21, 2014. In addition, the Motion states that the requested extension of time will allow negotiations to continue and potentially avoid the necessity of filing a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena.

Based on the foregoing, the Motion is GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that the deadline for UnitedHealthCare to file a motion to quash, or in the alternative to limit the Subpoena, is extended through and including October 21, 2014.
