**ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION OF NONPARTY UNITED
HEALTHCARE SERVICES, INC. TO EXTEND THE TIME TO FILE A MOTION TO
QUASH, OR IN THE ALTERNATIVE TO LIMIT, SUBPOENA *DUCES TECUM***

On October 14, 2014, nonparty United HealthCare Services, Inc., filed an Unopposed Motion to Extend the Time to File a Motion to Quash, or in the Alternative to Limit, Subpoena *Duces Tecum* served on United HealthCare Services, Inc. ("Motion"). The subpoena at issue was served by counsel for Respondents Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital, Inc., Phoebe Putney Health System, Inc., and Hospital Authority of Albany-Dougherty County (collectively, "Respondents") on October 3, 2014 ("Subpoena").

Aquaforest TIFF Junction Evaluation

The Motion requests an extension of the applicable deadline to file a motion to quash and/or limit the Subpoena under FTC Rule 3.34 until October 22, 2014.¹ United HealthCare Services, Inc. states that it is in the process of negotiating with Respondents' counsel over the breadth of the Subpoena, and its objections thereto, in a good faith effort to comply with its obligations, while reducing the burden imposed by the Subpoena. Further, United HealthCare Services, Inc. states that Respondents' counsel does not oppose an extension of time through October 22, 2014, and that such extension will enable negotiations to continue and potentially avoid the necessity of filing a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena.

Based on the foregoing, the Motion is GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that the deadline for United HealthCare Services, Inc., to file a motion to quash, or to limit the Subpoena is extended through and including October 22, 2014.
