**MOTION OF RESPONDENT JOHN FANNING TO ENLARGE TIME

COMPEL DISCOVERY FROM JOHN FANNING**

Respondent John Fanning (“Fanning”) requests an extension of time to file his response and opposition to Complaint Counsel’s Renewed Motion to Compel Discovery from John Fanning up to and including Friday, December 5, 2014. In support of the extension, Mr. Fanning states that on November 26, 2014, at 4:06 PM Commission Counsel served and filed a Renewed Motion to Compel Discovery from John Fanning. This was late afternoon the day before the Thanksgiving holiday on November 27, 2014, and the office for counsel for Respondent was closed on Friday, November 28, 2014.
