ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR MOTIONS
FOR *IN CAMERA* TREATMENT

Under Rule 3.45(b) of the Federal Trade Commission's Rules of Practice, the Administrative Law Judge may order that material offered into evidence "be placed *in camera* only after finding that its public disclosure will likely result in a clearly defined, serious injury to the person, partnership or corporation requesting *in camera* treatment or after finding that the material constitutes sensitive personal information." 16 C.F.R. § 3.45(b). Applicants for *in camera* treatment are directed to *In re LabMD*, 2014 FTC LEXIS 128 (May 6, 2014).

Trial in this matter is scheduled to resume on March 3, 2015. If a party or non-party has material that has been or will be offered into evidence, the deadline for filing a motion for *in camera* treatment is February 24, 2015. Any oppositions to motions for *in camera* treatment shall be filed by February 26, 2015. The parties are directed to provide this order to entities that have provided materials that the parties have or intend to offer into evidence.
