RESTRAINING ORDER TO EXTEND THE RECEIVERSHIP
TO INCLUDE DEFENDANTS' BUSINESS CONDUCTED
UNDER THE NAME FRI, INC. AND PERMIT
IMMEDIATE ACCESS TO ITS RECORDS

Plaintiff Federal Trade Commission ("the Commission"), having filed an *ex parte* motion to
amend the *Ex Parte* Temporary Restraining Order with Asset Freeze and Accounting, and Order

Appointing Receiver, Permitting Immediate Access to Defendants' Records, Granting Expedited Discovery, and Order to Show Cause Why a Preliminary Injunction Should Not Issue ("TRO"), entered by this Court on October 5, 1998, and good cause appearing thereto;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the TRO is amended to include within the receivership defendants' business identified as FRI, Inc., and that all the paragraphs in the TRO relating to the receivership, and relating to immediate access to defendant's premises, shall apply with equal force and effect to FRI, Inc. as though the words FRI, Inc. had been included in each and every such paragraph.
