**COMPLAINT COUNSEL’S NOTICE OF SUPPLEMENTAL AUTHORITY**

On December 18, 2020, Complaint Counsel moved the Commission to lift its stay of these proceedings and to set March 15, 2021 as the date for commencement of the evidentiary hearing. At the time of Complaint Counsel’s filing, Supreme Court Justice Samuel A. Alito had not yet acted on Respondent’s December 7, 2020 application seeking to stay issuance of the Fifth Circuit mandate or to stay further proceedings before the Commission. (*See Mot.* at 2-3.) Justice Alito subsequently denied Respondent’s application on December 18, 2020.<sup>1</sup>
