**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
MOTION FOR *IN CAMERA* TREATMENT**

On September 21, 2020, non-party Utility Associates, Inc. (“Utility”) filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File Motion for *In Camera* Treatment (“Motion”). Under the Revised Scheduling Order, the deadline for filing motions for *in camera* treatment is September 23, 2020. Utility seeks an extension of two days, to September 25, 2020. Utility states that the parties to this action, Federal Trade Commission (“FTC”) Complaint Counsel and Respondent Axon Enterprise, Inc. (“Respondent” or “Axon”), do not oppose the requested extension.

Utility states that on September 11, 2020, the parties each notified Utility of the intention to introduce certain documents and deposition testimony of Utility at trial. Utility further states that Utility and its counsel are in the process of reviewing the designated materials and identifying those for which Utility will seek *in camera* treatment, but avers that some additional time is needed to complete the review process and prepare the requisite showing for any materials Utility identifies as requiring *in camera* treatment. Utility further notes that it has not sought or obtained any other extensions of time in this proceeding.

Based on the foregoing, Utility has shown good cause for its request. *See* 16 C.F.R. 3.21(c)(2). Furthermore, the Motion is unopposed. Accordingly, the Motion is

GRANTED and it is hereby ORDERED that Utility's deadline to file a motion for *in camera* treatment is extended to September 25, 2020.
