ORDER STAYING ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING

On April 10, 2018, the Commission issued an Opinion and Order that denied Respondent’s motion to dismiss the complaint and dismissed Respondent’s third and ninth affirmative defenses.¹ On April 11, 2019, Respondent filed a Complaint for Violations of the Administrative Procedure Act and for Declaratory Relief with the United States District Court for the Middle District of Louisiana, seeking to set aside the Commission’s April 10, 2018 Order. Respondent moved the court to stay the FTC’s administrative proceedings. On July 29, 2019, the District Court granted Respondent’s motion and stayed this administrative proceeding until further order of that court. Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all proceedings before the Commission and the Administrative Law Judge in this matter, be, and hereby are, stayed until further order of the United States District Court for the Middle District of Louisiana and the Commission.
