16 Petitioner the Federal Trade Commission (“FTC”) filed a series of applications to enforce  
17 a civil investigative demand (“CID”) it had served on respondent Dinamica Financiera, LLC  
18 (“Dinamica”). On September 22, 2008, the court heard the FTC’s application for an order of  
19 civil contempt against Dinamica. Thereafter, the court entered an order holding Dinamica in civil  
20 contempt and imposing a daily monetary sanction of \$750.00, commencing October 7, 2008, for  
21 every day that Dinamica failed to provide the requested information and documents to the FTC.  
22 On December 19, 2008, the FTC notified the court that Dinamica had purged its contempt by  
23 providing a complete response to the CID. The court having considered the evidence presented  
24 by the parties,

25 IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that

- 26 1. Petitioner’s application for an order of civil contempt against respondent is granted;  
27 2. Respondent is ordered to pay petitioner a daily monetary sanction of \$750.00 for 74  
28

1 days (October 7, 2008 through December 19, 2008, inclusive), in an amount totaling \$55,500.00.
