The Court addresses the parties regarding the purpose of this hearing and notes the respondent filed a response to the movant’s petition (#18) and the movant filed a motion to seal reply (#19) and the reply (#20). Movant’s motion to seal reply (#19) is GRANTED.

Counsel present their respective positions regarding movant’s petition for an order enforcing civil investigative demands (#18).

Having heard from counsel and good cause appearing, the Court finds the respondents shall answer and provide full and complete responses to the CID interrogatories and requests for production of documents and address the issues specifically set out concerning the five categories in the reply (#19). In addition, the respondents shall provide sworn certifications that they have complied with the CIDs, consistent with the Federal Trade Commission Act.

The Court invites counsel to use the attorney rooms outside the courtroom to meet and confer in anticipation of completing the work the Court has ordered so the parties can leave here today with an understanding of how the parties will proceed.
