ORDERED that Respondent Mobilefunster, Inc., comply in full with the Commission's CID by producing all responsive documents and information in compliance with the CID within ten (10) days of the receipt of the Court's enforcement order, or at such later time as may be agreed upon by the parties.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a certified copy of this Order be served forthwith by Petitioner upon Respondent, its counsel, and/or its registered agent(s) by certified or registered mail with return receipt requested, or by overnight express delivery service.
