ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

THIS CAUSE came on for consideration upon the Petition of The Federal Trade Commission for an Order Enforcing Administrative Investigative Process (Doc. 1). The petitioner alleges that the respondent failed to comply fully with a civil investigative demand (CID) which required, among other things, responses to interrogatories and document requests (*id.*, pp. 6, 7). The petitioner therefore requests the issuance of an Order directing the respondent to appear and show cause why it should not comply in full with the CID (*id.*, p. 23). It is, upon consideration,

ORDERED that the respondent, TRACERS INFORMATION SPECIALISTS, INC., if desiring to object to an Order directing compliance with the subject CID, shall, within twenty (20) days from service of this Order, file with the court and serve upon the petitioner a written response to the Petition, supported by appropriate affidavits, as well as any motion the

respondent desires to make.

ORDERED that respondent, TRACERS INFORMATION SPECIALISTS, INC., shall appear before the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida, in Courtroom 12A, Sam M. Gibbons United States Courthouse, 801 North Florida Avenue, Tampa, Florida, on the 5th day of April, 2016, at 3:00 P.M., to show cause why the Petition should not be granted, and an Order entered enforcing the CID and directing the respondent to produce the documents and information requested by the CID within the time frame directed by the court. If the respondent raises no objection to complying with the subject CID, the respondent need not appear at the hearing set forth above, although the respondent will be bound to act in accordance with any Order of this court issued in this matter.

It is further

ORDERED that a copy of this Order, together with the Petition and the exhibits attached thereto, shall be served by the petitioner upon the respondent by personal service, or by certified or registered mail with return receipt requested, or by overnight express delivery service. Proof of any service shall be filed with the Clerk as soon as practicable.
