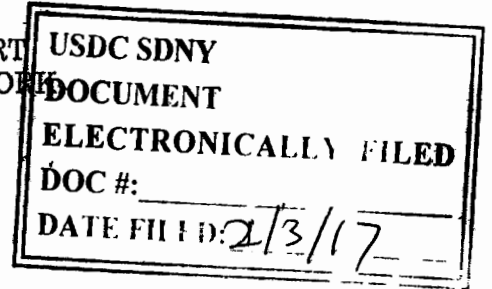

**JOINT STIPULATION OF DISMISSAL WITH PREJUDICE**
