Dear Mr. O'Leary:

This is in response to your request dated September 14, 2016 under the Freedom of Information Act seeking access to "documentation related to the merger of Fleetcor and Comdata, as well as any commentary from the associated deal review." Any records that a search may have located would be exempt from disclosure under FOIA Exemption 3, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(3), because that material is exempt from disclosure under another statutory provision. Specifically, 15 U.S.C. § 18a(h) exempts any information or documentary material that may have been filed pursuant to the Hart-Scott-Rodino premerger notification program. Therefore, we are denying your request.

If you are not satisfied with this response to your request, you may appeal by writing to Freedom of Information Act Appeal, Office of the General Counsel, Federal Trade Commission, 600 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20580, within 90 days of the date of this letter. Please enclose a copy of your original request and a copy of this response. If you believe that we should choose to disclose additional materials beyond what the FOIA requires, please explain why this would be in the public interest.
