In accordance with the FOIA and agency policy, we have searched our records as of April 26, 2017, the date we received your request in our FOIA office.

Consumer complaints concerning Uber and Lyft, dated through approximately December 7, 2016, are posted to the FTC's website at https://www.ftc.gov/about-ftc/foia/foia-reading-rooms/frequently-requested-records. We have located approximately 55 additional responsive complaints, concerning the various entities described in your request, that consumers have made to the Federal Trade Commission ("FTC"). You should know that the enclosed complaints have not necessarily been verified by the FTC. Therefore, you should make your own judgment about relying on the information provided. I am denying access to consumers' names and addresses, and any other identifying information found in the complaints. This information is exempt from release under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6), because individuals' right to privacy outweighs the general public's interest in seeing personal identifying information. See The Lakin Law Firm v. FTC, 352 F.3d 1122 (7th Cir. 2003).

If you are not satisfied with this response to your request, you may appeal by writing to Freedom of Information Act Appeal, Office of the General Counsel, Federal Trade Commission, 600 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20580, within 90 days of the date of this letter. Please enclose a copy of your original request and a copy of this response.
