To Whom It May Concern:

My name is Anish Babu and I am an IBO in Quixtar business. I have been a business owner for about 4 years.

I have read the proposal and agree with most of them but not all of them. I accept the proposal that the prospect should be give enough information before he starts the business. I cannot agree with the fact that they have to wait for 7 days after the disclosure. For example, if two brothers see the business plan and decided to join one under the other, it is not fair for them to wait one and two weeks – one week for the first person and a week from then for the second person. It reduces their chances to create income in the first month itself. My recommendation will be to eliminate the 7 day waiting period.

Also I do not agree that I have to provide reference of 10 other IBOs. I believe that is a violation of their privacy. Also when we start someone in the business, we recommend them to meet the business team in the local area in a meeting before they start. So that they can understand there are a lot of people doing the business in the area. Also, it creates the risk that the prospect may go and join someone else's business that we present as references. My recommendation will be to eliminate this requirement

In our presentation material we disclose that average IBO income. But I believe it is unfair for each IBO to disclose their income. If the sponsoring IBO is also a new IBO, how could he disclose the income. But we take them to a platinum level business owner so they the new person will have the idea of how much income that person is making through the business. My recommendation will be to eliminate this requirement too.
