

I have been an IBO with Quixtar for 13 years. I am also affiliated with World Wide Dream Builders ([www.wwdb.com](http://www.wwdb.com)) for the same amount of time. I got involved because I can take control of my financial future and we are on our way there. Being affiliated with both Quixtar and WWDB has made me a better person, citizen and has added value to every area of my life.

When I registered, I received the information I needed to make an informed decision and my wife and I do the same thing with the people we register today. When we contact prospects, we show them the business plan in a way that is approved by the FTC and explain them that it is not a “get rich quick”, which it is going to take effort and they are not guaranteed results. I talked to a friend one time and he said he was involved and showed 100 people and didn’t register one of them. And we follow up with our prospects and go over the same information and ask any questions they have. To get registered as an IBO powered by Quixtar, it costs about \$200, if they decide to build an organization.

Now, with a seven day waiting period, that would cause the excitement with the prospect to leave. I’m sure you know that we all make decisions based on emotions, not logic, if it we made decisions based on logic, we all would exercise everyday and eat very healthy and prolong our lives and that’s just one example. I love showing the business plan to people and they see a way out of their financial headache, which are most people. Plus it would hinder the ability to earn income for all IBOs.

Providing the prospect with local IBO information, they may decide to register with another person, when I did all the work, and that would be very unfair. Plus I believe that would be invading the privacy of me and others. I bring prospects to open meetings, where there are other IBOs and there is a lot of interaction taking place. And I have them meet my upline IBOs right after they register.

Providing litigation is like holding an accusation over someone when they are innocent. I’m sure you know of the integrity of the Quixtar business, in fact our business is your “model” when it comes to other businesses like it.

We show prospects the potential income they can earn in our business plan, including the SA-4400, and what the average income per IBO is.

If prospects ask me how much income I make as an IBO, I give them an idea. I also explain that I am involved for more than the money, but it has helped me tremendously in other areas of my life. Providing financial records would be an invasion of privacy, because earned income is a private subject.
