We are writing this letter because of our concern about the proposed Business Opportunity Rule R511993. We believe it could prevent us from being successful in our home business venture. One of the most disturbing sections of the proposed rule is the seven-day waiting period to enroll a new distributor. This is also unnecessary, because XanGo has a 30-day buy-back policy for the cost of the product.


