To Whom It May Concern:

Please accept this correspondence as my concerns on the above issue, as labeling does not resolve my concerns for this issue. I have raced numerous vehicles that run on ethanol or a mix there with race fuel. This mix is great for racing but terrible for components that are not designed for ethanol. It simply destroys them.

While equipment failures are easily resolved at a race track, these issues are not easily resolved when I am riding my snowmobiles in the backcountry and heavily dependent on my snowmobile to safely leave the backcountry. Throughout the western US, riders are consistently lost in the backcountry as a result of equipment failures unrelated to fuels. Increasing these risks simply is unacceptable to me
