To Whom It May Concern,

Please stop trying to force E-15 fuel as a satisfactory substitute for normal types of gasoline. Alcohol in gasoline attracts water, which is deadly for a high compression engine like those found in most of today's motorcycles. Manufacturing gasoline with alcohol with a corn base does nothing but harm to motorcycle engines and - in fact - many motorcycle manufacturers are now refusing to honor a warranty claim when the damage can be seen to have come from the use of alcohol based gasoline. Dumping in more corn to up the octane rating just compounds the issue. Please let common sense prevail.
