To Whom It May Concern,

The proposal to address the deleterious effects of fuels containing more than 10% ethanol by imposing labeling requirements is totally inadequate. Unless retail gas stations are also mandated to offer fuels with a maximum of 10% ethanol, tens of thousands of motorcycles will be stranded on the side of the road for lack of appropriate fuels that maintain compliance with manufacturer warranties, avoid serious and costly damage, and that do not impair the emissions devices of those vehicles.
