To Whom It May Concern,

You are unnecessarily putting the pursuit of happiness of millions of ATV and motorcycle owners at risk by promoting your rule for labeling blends of more than 10 percent ethanol. The proposed rule does not address the central issue that real-world motorcyclists face, and that is that no motorcycle currently on the road is approved for any fuel with higher than 10 percent ethanol, and the risk of inadvertent misfueling is tremendous once higher blends are available at the pump.

Help protect 22 million motorcycles and all-terrain vehicles in America -- and the riders who depend on their safe operation -- from inadvertent misfueling. All we want is safe access to fuel for our motorcycles and ATVs.
