As an optometrist, consumer and active participant in my community, I strongly urge you to stop any further requirements onto the Fairness to Contact Lens Consumers Act. I believe in the requirements of the existing FCLCA and feel that it is sufficient in protecting my patients and I already fully abide by it. Any further requirements onto this act such as requiring providers to get another signature upon releasing of the contact lens prescription is burdensome to the patient and the provider. In addition, it just adds to the paperwork and manpower to abide this ruling and will only add additional cost to the patient. I do not believe that adding this step will add any value or further protection to the patient. Please do not support this amendment.
