SEALED ORDER TEMPORARILY SEALING DOCKET AND CASE FILE¹

THIS CAUSE is before the Court upon Federal Trade Commission's *Ex Parte* Motion to Seal the Docket and Case File Temporarily (DE [5]). Good cause being shown, it is accordingly **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the motion is **GRANTED** as follows:

1. The docket and entire case file, including Plaintiff's Complaint, all pleadings, motions, memoranda, exhibits, and orders entered by this Court, shall be sealed, with the exception that the Clerk of the Court shall provide Plaintiff's counsel with a signed copy of this Order, any other Orders issued in this case before the seal is lifted, and any documents required for service of process.
2. This Order shall not be construed to prohibit service or disclosure by Plaintiff of any papers or orders filed in this action to (i) the parties; (ii) any temporary receiver appointed by the Court; (iii) non-party financial institutions or other third parties that

may be holding any assets of Defendants; (iv) criminal law enforcement authorities; or (v) credit reporting agencies.

3. This seal shall expire at 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time five (5) business days following the entry of this Order or when all Defendants are served, whichever occurs first.
