ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION TO EXTEND SCHEDULING DEADLINES

On January 3, 2024, Respondents IQVIA Holdings Inc. and Propel Media, Inc. ("Respondents") filed an unopposed motion to extend the deadlines in the Scheduling Order ("Motion to Extend"). Also on January 3, 2024, Respondents and Complaint Counsel filed a joint motion with the Commission to withdraw this matter from adjudication ("Motion to Withdraw").

Extending the deadlines for filing labor-intensive motions for *in camera* treatment of proposed trial exhibits and deadlines relating to identifying final exhibits and witnesses will alleviate the burden on the Court, on the parties, and on non-parties, should the Commission grant the Joint Motion to Withdraw. Therefore, all pretrial deadlines will be extended.

Accordingly, Respondents' Unopposed Motionto Extend is GRANTED.

The remaining deadlines are amended as follows:

January 9, 2024 – Parties exchange final proposed witness and exhibit lists. The parties provide courtesy copies to the ALJ of their final proposed witness and exhibit lists, the basis of admissibility for each proposed exhibit, and a brief summary of the testimony of each witness, including expert witnesses.

January 9, 2024 – Complaint Counsel to identify rebuttal expert(s) and provide rebuttal expert report(s).

January 9, 2024 – Exchange and serve courtesy copy on ALJ of objections to final proposed witness lists and exhibit lists.

January 9, 2024 – Deadline for depositions of experts (including rebuttal experts) and exchange of expert related exhibits.

January 12, 2024 – Complaint Counsel files pretrial brief supported by legal authority.

January 16, 2024 – Respondents' Counsel files pretrial brief supported by legal authority.

January 16, 2024 – Exchange proposed stipulations of law, facts, and authenticity.

January 16, 2024 – Deadline for filing motions *in limine* to preclude admission of evidence.

January 16, 2024 – Deadline for filing motions for *in camera* treatment of proposed trial exhibits.

January 17, 2024 – Deadline for filing responses to motions *in limine* to preclude admission of evidence.

January 17, 2024 – Deadline for filing responses to motions for *in camera* treatment of proposed trial exhibits.

January 18, 2024 – Final prehearing conference, to begin at 9:45 a.m. ET.

January 18, 2024 – Evidentiary hearing to begin at 10:00 a.m. ET.
