**NON-PARTY VALLARTA FOOD ENTERPRISES, INC.'S UNOPPOSED MOTION
TO EXTEND THE TIME TO MOVE TO QUASH OR LIMIT SUBPOENA**

Non-party Vallarta Food Enterprises, Inc. (“Vallarta”), by and through its undersigned counsel, hereby moves, pursuant to Rules 3.22, 3.34, and 4.3 of the Federal Trade Commission’s (“FTC”) Rules of Practice for Adjudicative Proceedings, to further extend its time to move to quash or limit the Subpoena for Production of Documentary Material (“Subpoena”) issued by the FTC in the above-captioned proceeding on April 15, 2024.

In support thereof, Vallarta states as follows:

The Subpoena was served on Vallarta on April 15, 2024.

By order dated May 23, 2024, the time for Vallarta to file a motion to quash or to limit subpoena was extended to May 30, 2024.

Counsel for Vallarta and counsel for the FTC continued to engage in negotiations regarding the scope of the Subpoena and the time required for Vallarta to produce responsive documents. Following the meet and confer on April 24, 2024, the parties’ counsel met again on April 30, May 10, and May 21, 2024. On May 29, counsel for the FTC informed Vallarta’s counsel that the FTC will not oppose this motion for a further fourteen (14) days extension of Vallarta’s deadline to object or otherwise move to limit or quash the subpoena.

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This further extension that has been agreed upon to afford Vallarta sufficient time to negotiate with counsel for the FTC regarding reasonable limitations and modifications of the Subpoena to reduce the burden on Vallarta of responding as a third party and thereby potentially avoid the necessity of filing a motion to quash or to limit the Subpoena.

Accordingly, Vallarta respectfully requests that this unopposed motion to extend the time to file a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena be granted and that Vallarta be given until June 13, 2024, to file any such motion. A proposed order granting the requested relief is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
