ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On May 21, 2024, Appellants Elanor Martin and Oscar Ceballos (“Appellants”) filed a Notice of Appeal and Application for Review, appealing the final civil sanctions imposed by the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority (“Authority”). On June 5, 2024, an order was issued denying Appellants’ request for an evidentiary hearing and setting a briefing schedule.

The parties have informed the Federal Trade Commission’s Office of Administrative Law Judges that the hearing below that was held before the Authority on April 16, 2024 was not recorded in its entirety. The parties were directed to confer in an effort to stipulate to the substance of the testimony that was not recorded and/or the material facts established by such testimony, and to report back on the results by June 24, 2024. On June 24, 2024, the parties filed a joint motion seeking a two-day extension to submit the joint stipulation regarding the testimony before the Authority and to file a joint motion to stay the briefing deadlines (“Joint Motion”).

The Joint Motion is GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that the deadline to submit the joint stipulation regarding the hearing before the Authority and the joint motion to stay the briefing deadlines is extended to June 26, 2024.
