JOINT MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE FOR *IN CAMERA* MOTIONS

On May 7, 2025, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit affirmed the decision of the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of California denying the Commission's application for a preliminary injunction pursuant to Section 13(b) of the FTC Act, 15 U.S.C. § 53(b). This matter originally was scheduled for an evidentiary hearing on August 2, 2023, and the Commission subsequently delayed the hearing until 21 days after the decision of the Ninth Circuit. *Order Returning Matter to Adjudication*, Docket No. 9412 (FTC Sep. 26, 2023), available at https://www.ftc.gov/system/files/ftc_gov/pdf/608644.2023.09.25_d09412_-_order_returning_matter_to_adjudication.pdf.

Complaint Counsel and Respondents are filing a Joint Motion to Change Hearing Date and Vacate All Interim Pretrial Deadlines to the Commission, which, if granted, would change

the date of the evidentiary hearing to July 21, 2025 and vacate current pretrial deadlines until further order of the Office of Administrative Law Judges. To avoid burdening nonparties, the parties, and Office of Administrative Law Judges while the Commission considers the joint motion, Complaint Counsel and Respondents jointly move for a one week extension of the deadline for *in camera* motions.
