**ORDER DENYING NON-PARTY NINTENDO OF AMERICA, INC.’S
MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE FOR FILING *IN CAMERA* MOTION AS MOOT**

On May 8, 2025, non-party Nintendo of America Inc. (“NOA”) filed a motion to extend the time for it to file a motion for *in camera* treatment of proposed trial exhibits by seven days (“Motion”), together with a request to expedite the deadlines for briefing and ruling on the Motion. On May 9, 2025, NOA’s request to expedite the deadlines for briefing and ruling on the Motion was granted.

On May 12, 2025, Complaint Counsel and Respondents filed a joint motion to extend the deadline for *in camera* motions by one week, the same relief NOA seeks. By order dated May 12, 2025, the parties’ joint motion was granted and the deadline for *in camera* motions was extended to May 21, 2025.

Accordingly, NOA’s Motion is hereby DENIED as moot.
