**ORDER DENYING RELIEF #2**

Appellant Zvi Kriple, appearing pro se, submitted a document styled “Motion for Leave to Supplement the Record,” which includes a signed “Supplemental Declaration” and what is represented as an “Application for Emergency Stay.”

FTC Rule 1.146(a)(1) provides that, “[e]xcept for good cause shown, no assignment of error by the aggrieved party may rely on any question of fact or law not presented to the Authority.” Mr. Kriple has not shown, on his Motion: (a) what parts of his Supplemental Declaration, if any, are not already included in the record of the proceedings underlying this review; and (b) for those parts that may not be included, good cause for their omission and for now adding them to the record on this review.

It is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. Mr. Kriple’s Motion for Leave to Supplement the Record is **DENIED**; and
2. Insofar as Mr. Kriple may be seeking any other relief in the papers submitted, that relief is also **DENIED**.

For avoidance of doubt, the sanctions imposed on Mr. Kriple, which are the subject of this review proceeding, remain in effect.
