ORDER RESETTING EVIDENTIARY HEARING DATE

The stay directed by the January 30, 2026 Order of the Commission ended yesterday. Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The evidentiary hearing previously scheduled for February 4, 2026 is rescheduled to be conducted remotely via videoconferencing on February 19, 2026, commencing at 11:00 a.m. EST. Mr. Terrazas will be the only witness. The hearing will be transcribed by a court reporter, and an audio line will be provided for public access.
2. Counsel for Mr. Juarez will call and examine Mr. Terrazas. Examination by counsel for the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority will follow that of counsel for Mr. Juarez. Redirect and recross examination will be permitted. After counsel for the parties have concluded their examinations, the Court may have questions as well.
