The Authority has considered the findings concerning the source of Testosterone detected in a Sample collected from each of Appellant’s Covered Horses, Tigger Attack and Childersattack, made in the Decision under appeal¹ and in the ALJ’s Decision on Application for Review in *In the Matter of Dr. Donald McCrosky*,² respectively.

The Authority hereby represents that both the Authority and Appellant stipulate and agree that the source of Testosterone in Appellant’s Covered Horses, Childersattack and Tigger Attack, which gave rise to the two Adverse Analytical Findings for Testosterone at issue in this appeal was a Testosterone injection given to each Covered Horse by Dr. Donald McCrosky, who was the Covered Horses’ Veterinarian at the relevant time.
