<sup>1</sup> The Court previously denied the parties' Joint Motion without prejudice and instructed the parties to file a renewed Joint Motion that "specifies and justifies a reasonable tailored period of time for the Court to retain jurisdiction over this matter" [ECF No. 5]. As noted in the Renewed Joint Motion, "the parties have agreed to remove the 'Retention of Jurisdiction' provision from the Stipulated Order [ECF No. 6 p. 1]."

2. The Clerk shall **CLOSE** this case. Any scheduled hearings are **CANCELED**, any pending motions are **DENIED AS MOOT**, and all deadlines are **TERMINATED**.
