

ORDER RESETTING INITIAL PREHEARING SCHEDULING CONFERENCE

On April 18, 2022, Respondent Intuit Inc. and Complaint Counsel for the Federal Trade Commission (“FTC”) filed a joint motion to continue the prehearing scheduling conference currently scheduled to be held on April 22, 2022, at 3:00 p.m., EDT (“Joint Motion”). The parties state that they will be appearing in the U.S. District Court for the District of Northern California for a hearing on the FTC’s motion for a temporary restraining order and a preliminary injunction in related federal litigation on April 21, 2022 and that a continuance to April 25, 2022, or a date thereafter would allow the parties to meet pursuant to Commission Rule 3.21(a) immediately following the April 21, 2022 hearing, accommodate the parties’ travel from the April 21 hearing, and provide sufficient time for the parties to prepare for the scheduling conference.

Based on the foregoing, the Joint Motion is GRANTED. It is hereby ORDERED that the prehearing scheduling conference pursuant to Rule 3.21(b) will be held on April 25, 4:00 p.m. EDT. Due to ongoing public health concerns related to COVID-19, the scheduling conference will be conducted telephonically. The proceedings will be stenographically recorded. To the extent practicable, members of the press and public will be allowed to access the proceedings of the scheduling conference via a public call-in number. Interested parties are directed to check the Office of Public Affairs section of the FTC website or contact the FTC Office of Public Affairs for call-in information.
