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**RE: Written Application of Everbloom Bio Inc. for a New Generic Fiber Name
and Definition Under the Rules and Regulations Under the Textile Fiber
Products Identification Act, 16 C.F.R. §303**

Ms. Swenson and Mr. Phillips:

On June 29, 2026, Everbloom Bio Inc. (“Everbloom”) submitted a written application to the Federal Trade Commission (the “Commission”) requesting the establishment of a generic name for its fiber, renoa, pursuant to Section 303.8(a) of the Rules and Regulations under the Textile Fiber Products Identification Act (“Textile Rules”).¹ In accordance with Section 303.8(b) of the Textile Rules,² the Commission has assigned the designation “EB001” to Everbloom for temporary use (“Temporary Designation”) until a final determination can be made as to the merits of its application.

The assignment of this Temporary Designation should not be construed as indicative of the Commission’s final determination regarding the application (e.g., establishing a generic name or refusing to grant the application).³ This designation does not mean the Commission has determined that the application is complete.
